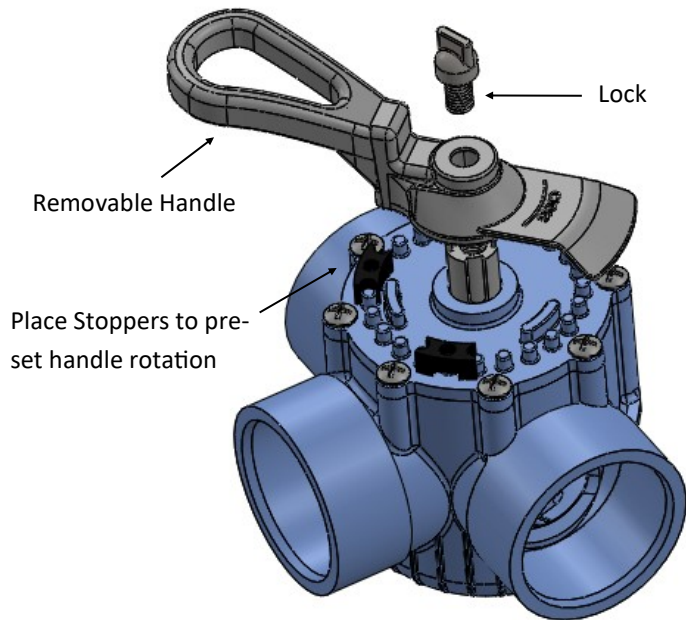


2" / 2.5" 2 and 3 Way(Port)

CMI's 2 port & 3 port valves are manufactured from high quality CPVC to ensure high reliability and low maintenance. They are suitable for 2" and 2.5" high pressure PVC/CPVC pipe and utilize a Teflon seal for smooth turning action and minimal maintenance.

Two Removable stoppers are supplied which can be installed to preset the stopping position when the valve is used manually. The stops should be removed and discarded when installing a motorized actuator.

The valves are provided with a removable handle to enable the installing of industry stand motorized actuators.



- ⚠ Stoppers May Present a pinch point - turn handle with care
- ⚠ Remove and discard stoppers when installing a motorized actuator
- ⚠ Never use a power driver to remove or tighten screws - plastic may strip
- ⚠ When installing a motorized Actuators - read instructions for actuator installing and operation

MAINTENANCE

Little or no maintenance is required, however, the following maintenance tips should be followed

- In areas with high levels of sand, soil or other fine debris, remove the seal, wash all internal surfaces thoroughly with warm water and grease the seal with a non-petroleum based lubricant.
- In frequent use applications, particularly when exposed to abrasive elements or high chemical concentrations the rotation seal and shaft O rings may need replacement to maintain a positive water seal.

WARRANTY

CMI warrants that, subject to the exclusions and limitation that follow, the product will be free from defects in materials and workmanship during the warranty period. The warranty period for your CPVC valve is 12 months and commences from the date of purchase which must be proved by the retailer invoice.

If a defect in materials or workmanship occurs within the warranty period CMI will offer a replacement valve or part.

EXCLUSIONS

The warranty will not apply where:

- The customer has not complied with CMI's terms and conditions of sale
- The product was used in an application for which it wasn't intended
- The product was altered, modified or repaired by any other person than CMI or its Authorized Service Agents
- The product has not been installed, maintained or operated in accordance with the Installation and Operation Instructions
- The product has been subject to misuse, abuse, negligence, alterations or accident

Specific warranty exclusions include but are not limited to:

- Normal wear and tear to consumable items such as gaskets, O-rings and seals
- Environmental influences such as flooding, storm, lighting, fire
- Incorrect installation
- Glue on rotating parts or mating surfaces
